



The City of Tucson is providing wireless access to members of the community to support remote learning, telework, and access to virtual services. This Community Wireless Program is paid for through funds received from the Federal CARES Act Coronavirus Relief Fund. Internet services will be available until December 31, 2021 to those who qualify and are selected through an application process.

Applications will be processed starting on December 9, 2020. The application period will close on December 21, 2020 and notification of application approval will go out to applicants during the week of December 31, 2020.
